ABOUT THE COURSE

Third cycle education course

This course analyses Swedish old age care in an international perspective, including organization of health care and social services as well as cultural and ethical aspects in old age care using both lectures, seminars, group discussions and field studies. All teaching will be in English.

Students in bi-lingual pairs will reflect on how care is organized and implemented.

COURSE PERIOD

The course consists of 3 weeks full-time studies.

May 17-18, 2018 and May 21-24, 2018 will be held on campus at the School of Health and Welfare, Jönköping University.
