





THEORETICAL PERSPECTIVES ON METHODOLOGICAL CHOICES IN RESEARCH ON AGEING AND HEALTH, 3 ECTS

The Swedish National Graduate School for Competitive Science on Ageing and Health (SWEAH) invites PhD students affiliated to SWEAH to apply for the course **Theoretical perspectives on methodological choices in research on ageing and health**, 3 ECTS. This course is open for PhD students within the field of ageing and health. Since the course is included as one of the courses in the specific SWEAH curriculum, priority is given to PhD student affiliated with SWEAH.

The course will be held in English and implemented as a distance learning course using the online learning platform Moodle and one face-to-face workshop located in Lund. The course starts online February 14, 2019, with individual as well as group assignments. The date of the face-to-face workshop is March 12-13 which is followed by individual work until the examination seminar May 28: web based or face-to-face, depending on individual preference. The deadline for the final examination task is June 14, 2019.

The aim of the course is to provide students with specialized knowledge of perspectives based on theories of methods and theories of science, and with considerations and arguments concerning research methods within research on ageing and health. The course deals with theoretical perspectives on quantitative, qualitative and mixed methods, as well as with the implications of method choices and interpretation of research results in the planned and ongoing thesis projects of the participants.
