

Ten years with new knowledge

From 2014 to 2021, the Swedish National Graduate School on Ageing and Health (SWEAH) was funded by the Swedish Research Council. From 1 January 2022, SWEAH is funded by a consortium of 13 Swedish higher education institutions.

SWEAH's vision is to contribute knowledge about ageing and health, with particular consideration for the complexity of ageing in the society of today and tomorrow.

70 defended theses

After the first thesis in 2018 by a SWEAH PhD, another 69 doctorates have been awarded to many topics within the field of ageing and health, ranging from information and communication technology, nutritional perspectives, genetics and biomarkers of frailty - to machine learning.

SWEAH organizes 1-2 courses every year. Ongoing course this year is "Theories of Ageing" and later this autumn the interdisciplinary doctoral course "Ageing and social change".
